Kopergaon: Students can achieve success and live a prosperous life by following the five key principles of Chanakya Neeti — Bakadhyani (heron-like focus), Kakcheshta (curiosity like a crow), Shwananidra (alertness like a dog), Alpahari (moderation in diet), and Gruhatyagi (detachment from comforts). Youth possess immense energy, but it is important to channel it in the right direction, advised Shri Mahesh Sawant, Tehsildar of Kopergaon.

He was addressing students and parents at the welcome ceremony for newly admitted students in the six-year Integrated B.Tech (after 10th) in Computer Science & Engineering at Sanjivani School of Engineering & Technology under Sanjivani University. The event was presided over by University President Shri Amit Kolhe. Also present on the dais were Mrs. Manjiri Kulkarni, Corporate Head and Trainer at iSource Infosystem Pvt. Ltd., Vice Chancellor Dr. A.G. Thakur, and Dean Dr. Kavitha Rani P.

The program began with Dr. Thakur and Dr. Kavitha Rani welcoming attendees and explaining the course structure, rules, and future opportunities.

Mr. Sawant elaborated on the five principles:

- **Shwananidra** – Like a dog that sleeps lightly yet remains alert, students should stay aware and vigilant in their learning.
- **Alpahari** – Eat only as much as needed to maintain energy for focused study and performance.
- **Gruhatyagi** – Students should detach from the comforts and distractions of home to pursue knowledge wholeheartedly.

He likened the teacher-student relationship to that of a potter and a clay pot — one hand shapes with pressure while the other supports from within. Teachers may appear strict but are always supportive of students' growth.

Mrs. Manjiri Kulkarni emphasized the importance of building a strong network of good friends and maintaining a positive mindset. She said, "Every problem has a solution; never lose patience or resilience." She also highlighted key skills needed for future interviews, such as body language, tone of speech, and proper word usage. "Time once lost cannot be regained, so manage it wisely while absorbing various skills. Accept reality and adapt accordingly. Lifelong learning is the key to progress.

President Shri Amit Kolhe, in his presidential address, recalled that around 42 years ago, the late Shri Shankarrao Kolhe founded Sanjivani Group to provide quality education to rural youth. Today, Sanjivani alumni are working across the globe. Under the leadership of Shri Nitindada Kolhe, all institutions under Sanjivani are progressing effectively. He stressed that every student should strive to become self-reliant by choosing one of the three paths — employment, higher education, or entrepreneurship. Mechanical Engineering Department Concludes 1-Week STTP on Research & Innovation


